2020/21 Financial Reports for lands granted to the University of California

Dear Ms. Moser.

We are responding to your request for an annual financial report associated with the property granted to the Regents of the University of California by the State. During fiscal year 20/21, Scripps Institution of Oceanography, did not receive any revenue from outside use of the Scripps Pier. We are not aware of any other revenues, with the possible exception of an annual surfing contest, sponsored by the UCSD Cancer Center Foundation for charitable purposes, and all funds were retained by the Cancer Center.

In 2020/21, the University incurred costs of approximately \$2,043.90 in Pier upkeep, \$600,581 in capital improvements for repairs and upgrades of seawater system, replacement (fabrication and installation) of Jacob's ladder for scientific diving program, and \$76,941 to provide lifeguard services for this area during the summer and on holidays or FY2021. University resources are also used to maintain the surrounding area and seawalls, and to empty trash and keep the beach clean.
