**NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND INTENT TO ADOPT A  
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

(State CEQA Guidelines, sections 15072 and 15073)

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) has been prepared by the California State Lands Commission (CSLC), as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.), in response to an application submitted by the California Resources Corporation (CRC) for the California Resources Corporation Grubb Lease (PRC 3913.1) Intake/Outfall Structures Decommissioning Project (Project). The MND was prepared in compliance with the requirements of CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.), and CSLC Regulations (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 2901 et seq.).

**Project Title:** California Resources Corporation Grubb Lease (PRC 3913.1) Intake/Outfall Structures Decommissioning Project

**Project Location:** On the shoreline of the Pacific Ocean, approximately 1.3 miles east-southeast of Pitas Point, Ventura County

**Project Description:** The Project proposes to remove three offshore 12-inch-diameter seawater intake and discharge pipelines, the shoreline vault structure down to minus 5 feet below the sand line, and three onshore seawater pipelines (if feasible). The 36-inch-diameter steel casing with the three onshore pipelines would be abandoned in place along with any portion of the internal pipelines that remain. The shoreline vault void would then be reconstructed to match the existing armored rock contour along the Pacific Coast Highway.
