**NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER AN ADDENDUM TO A
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

(State CEQA Guidelines, sections 15072 and 15073)

An Addendum to a previously adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared by the California State Lands Commission (CSLC), as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.) to amend General Lease – Right-of-Way Use (Lease 9632) to install, use, and maintain one, 2-inch-diameter subsea fiber optic cable and four, 6-inch-diameter steel conduits in the Pacific Ocean off of the City of Grover Beach. The Addendum is in compliance with the requirements of CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.).

Project Title: RTI Infrastructure, Inc. Grover Beach Subsea Fiber Optic Cables Project

Project Location: Land and ocean areas in and offshore the City of Grover Beach, San Luis Obispo County

Project Description: The MND and Addendum to the MND analyze the installation, use, and maintenance of up to six, 6-inch-diameter steel conduits starting from the Grover Beach parking lot and exiting offshore in the Pacific Ocean; up to six, 2-inch-diameter subsea fiber optic cables; two underground landing systems under the Grover Beach surface streets; and other related infrastructure needed to support these structures.
