Dear Shipping Agents and Interested Parties:

Regulatory amendments to section 2298.5 in Article 4.8 of Title 2, Division 3, Chapter 1 of the California Code of Regulations have been approved by the California State Lands Commission (Commission) and the Office of Administrative Law and filed with the Secretary of State. <u>The regulatory changes become effective on January 1, 2021</u>.

The amended regulations require annual submission of the *Marine Invasive Species Program Annual Vessel Reporting Form* (AVRF) through the web-based platform MISP.IO at least 24 hours prior to a vessel's first arrival at a California port during each calendar year.

Commission staff produced a webinar on October 7, 2020, highlighting the regulatory changes and the process of creating a user account on the web-based platform MISP.IO. We are working through a technical issue to post these webinar presentations on our website at https://www.slc.ca.gov/misp/; we anticipate these presentations becoming available for viewing by Monday, December 7, 2020.

Commission staff will provide an additional webinar on December 15, 2020, at 11:00 AM (PST), to walk viewers through the process of completing and submitting the AVRF through the webbased platform MISP.IO. The information for this webinar will be posted on our website within a few days.

The Commission has committed to not enforcing this requirement during the first year, but it is a regulatory requirement, and we encourage the regulated industry to comply. There is an alternatives provision in section 2298.9 in Article 4.8 of Title 2, Division 3, Chapter 1 of the California Code of Regulations. If an owner or operator plans to explore this alternative provision, we encourage them to contact us as soon as possible.
