**NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND INTENT TO ADOPT A
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

(State CEQA Guidelines, sections 15072 and 15073)

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) has been prepared by the California State Lands Commission (CSLC), as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.), in response to an application submitted by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) for the Pacific Gas & Electric Company Line 057A-1 McDonald Island to Palm Tract Pipeline Decommissioning Project (Project). The MND was prepared in compliance with the requirements of CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.), and CSLC Regulations (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 2901 et seq.).

Project Title: Pacific Gas & Electric Company Line 057A-1 McDonald Island to Palm Tract Pipeline Decommissioning Project

Project Location: Approximately 126.5 acres of tidally influenced river crossings (Latham Slough, Middle River, and Old River) and associated levees that protect agricultural lands on McDonald Island, Bacon Island, and Palm Tract in the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta

Project Description: PG&E proposes to decommission and remove four segments of the previously retired L-057A-1 natural gas pipeline at the Latham Slough, Mildred Island, Middle River, and Old River crossings.
