Honorable Chairperson Kounalakis and Members of the Commission:

Endangered Habitats League recognizes the important steps your Commission took on the renewal of this lease, and thanks you for them. We must note, though, that unlawful and hazardous trespass, as well as unlawful dog activities, continue to occur on the property, in violation of lease provisions. These activities are harassing endangered plovers and terns, and depleting their fat stores, which they need for breeding and migration. For these reasons, we ask you to seek enforcement, including moving quickly and effectively to secure funding for third party enforcement, as contemplated in the lease. If the situation does not improve, we urge additional steps to ensure compliance, such as rental charges to fund the third party enforcement.
