Piers 421 Field Trip: Additional Information

Time: Approximately 11:00 am

Location: Haskell's Beach, South of the Sandpiper Golf Course

Description: The State Lands Commission will visit the Piers 421 Decommissioning Project site located below the bluffs marking the southwestern limit of the Sandpiper Golf Course, in the city of Goleta. The field trip will end around 12:00 pm, in time for the Commission to convene its 1:00 p.m. meeting at the City of Goleta, Council Chambers. The public is invited to attend the field trip by meeting at the parking area (see map below) in their own private vehicles. Please note that carpooling and ride sharing is strongly encouraged as parking is very limited. The field trip will involve pedestrian travel along the beach up to a 2-mile, round trip, with uneven terrain. Proper attire, including sturdy, closed-toe footwear, should be worn. Because the Piers themselves remain an oil and gas facility, all members of the public who wish to attend will need to sign a liability waiver.
