## Rincon Island Field Trip: Additional Information

### **Event Details:**

**Date:** April 27, 2022

**Time:** Approximately 11:00 am

**Location:** Entrance to the Rincon Island causeway

**Description:** The State Lands Commission will visit Rincon Island, via the elevated causeway linking the island to shore. The site visit will begin at the entrance to the Rincon Island causeway, located just south of the intersection of Ocean Avenue and Breakers Way, Mussel Shoals. The site visit will conclude at approximately 12:30 p.m. The public is invited to attend in their own private vehicles. Please note that carpooling and ride sharing is strongly encouraged as parking is very limited. The island will be accessed by pedestrian entry at the causeway entrance and may involve a distance of up to 1.25 miles, roundtrip. No vehicular traffic will be allowed across the causeway. The terrain is uneven and proper attire, including sturdy, closed-toe footwear, should be worn. Because Rincon Island and its causeway is an active work site, all members of the public who wish to attend will need to sign a liability waiver.
