# Staff Report 51

## LESSEE:

Imperial Irrigation District

## PROPOSED ACTION:

Revision of Rent

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

18.13 acres, more or less, of State indemnity school land and lieu land in a portion of Section 30 and Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 13 East, SBM, on the east side of the Salton Sea, near Mecca, Imperial and Riverside Counties.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 230 kilovolt (kV) overhead electric transmission line.

#### TERM:

49 years, beginning January 1, 1988.

#### CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$991 per year to \$1,224 per year, effective January 1, 2023.

## **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

 Approval or denial of the revision of rent is a discretionary action by the Commission. Each time the Commission approves or rejects a revision of rent, it exercises legislatively delegated authority and responsibility as trustee of the State's Public Lands as authorized by law. The Lessee has no right to a new lease or to renewal of any previous lease.

- 2. On April 12, 1988, the Commission authorized a General Lease Right-of-Way Use to the Lessee for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a 230 kV overhead electric transmission line (<u>Item 13, April 12, 1988</u>), effective January 1, 1988. On November 29, 2017, the Commission approved (<u>Item 64, November 29, 2017</u>) an increase in the annual rent from \$942 to \$991, effective January 1, 2018. The lease will expire on December 31, 2036.
- 3. This action is consistent with addressing the challenges and opportunities described in the Commission's 2021-25 Strategic Plan to "Embrace and safeguard multi-benefit School Lands and resource management stewardship that equitably balances responsible local and regional economic development, supports living wages, environmental protection, and revenue generation."
- 4. Approving the revision of rent is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act because it is an administrative action that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
  - Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15378, subdivision (b)(5).


A. Site and Location Map


