The Coalition for San Francisco Neighborhoods warmly welcomes Controller Malia Cohen to the State Lands Commission.

As Controller Cohen was born and raised in San Francisco, we are proud to call her one of our own.

The Coalition for San Francisco Neighborhoods has already been advocating at the State Lands Commission for issues under the State Lands Commission's purview in terms of the public trust doctrine.

These issues include:

- Advocating for an ocean water pump station for the San Francisco's Emergency Firefighting Water System to be located at San Francisco's Ocean Beach near the Oceanside Treatment Facility.
- Advocating for an onshore or offshore desalination (desal) facility near the Oceanside Treatment Facility.
- As part of California's 30x30 Strategy, advocating for the waters off San Francisco's Ocean Beach to be designated as part of a National Marine Sanctuary.
- The Coalition for San Francisco Neighborhoods intends to begin advocating for revisions to sandmining permits in San Francisco Bay as this sandmining is exacerbating erosion and accretion on San Francisco's Ocean Beach.

The Coalition for San Francisco Neighborhoods looks forward to working with Controller Cohen and her Deputy Controller for Environmental Policy, Kristina Kunkel, on these issues.
