## CHAPTER 11

An act to add Section 2.6 to Chapter 1333 of the Statutes of 1968, relating to harbors and ports.

[Approved by Governor February 19, 1984. Filed with Secretary of State February 21, 1984.]

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2.6 is added to Chapter 1333 of the Statutes of 1968, to read:

Sec. 2.6. The Director of Transportation shall, in consultation with the Director of Finance, negotiate with the Port Commission of the City and County of San Francisco for the transfer, subject to the conditions and reservations contained in this act, to the City and County of San Francisco, in trust for the purposes of this act, of that property within the City and County of San Francisco under the jurisdiction or control of the state within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the southwesterly line of Second Street with the northwesterly line of Berry Street, and thence running northwesterly along that line of Second Street 275.00 feet to the southeasterly line of King Street; thence at a right angle southwesterly along that line of King Street 825.00 feet to the northeasterly line of Third Street; thence at a right angle southeasterly along that line of Third Street 275.00 feet to the northwesterly line of Berry Street; thence at a right angle northeasterly along the line of Berry Street 825 feet, more or less, to the southwesterly line of Second Street and the point of beginning; being a portion of 100 vera block 361; being also lots 3, 3B, 3C, 12, 13, 16, 17, 19, and 20 in Assessor's Block 3794; and containing 226,875 square feet more or less.
