RESCISSION OF MINUTE ITEM 50 APPROVED BY THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AT ITS JUNE 26, 2006 MEETING

APPLICANTS:

Robert H. Globus, Jr. and Kim M. Broaddus

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 37400 South River Road, near the town of Clarksburg, Yolo County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction, use, and maintenance of an uncovered floating boat dock, pilings, and gangway, and use and maintenance of existing bank protection.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning June 1, 2006.

CONSIDERATION:

Uncovered floating boat dock, pilings, and gangway: No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

Bank Protection: The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance of no less than \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. At its June 26, 2006, meeting, the Commission authorized the approval of Lease No. PRC 8689.9, a General Lease Recreational and Protective Structure Use. The Applicants sold the upland on June 13, 2006 without

notifying Commission staff and the Lease was never executed. Staff has verified that the uncovered floating boat dock, pilings, and gangway were never built. The existing bank protection is authorized under Lease No. PRC 8679.9 with the California Department of Water Resources. Staff recommends that the Commission's June 26, 2006 authorization be rescinded.

3. The staff recommends that the Commission find that the subject recession of the Commission's previous action does not have a potential for resulting in either a direct or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and is, therefore, not a project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, sections 15060, subdivision (c)(3), and 15378.
