RETROCESSION OF CONCURRENT JURISDICTION

On April 28, 1977 the State Lands Commission authorized a public hearing to determine whether or not it was in the interest of the State to accept a retrocession of concurrent jurisdiction from the Veterans Administration over Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery; Golden Gate National Cemetery; San Francisco National Cemetery; Veterans Administration National Cemetery, Riverside; Veterans Administration Hospital, Livermore; Veterans Administration Hospital, Long Beach; Veterans Administration Hospital, Palo Alto; Veterans Administration Hospital, San Francisco; Veterans Administration Hospital, Los Angeles (Brentwood); Veterans Administration Hospital, Los Angeles (Wadsworth). Public hearings were held on June 30, 1977 and July 28, 1977 pursuant to Section 113 of the California Government Code. All requirements of Section 113 were complied with. At the public hearings no objections were heard to the retrocession of concurrent jurisdiction.

All requirements of Section 113 of the California Government Code have been met by the parties involved. All the conditions prescribed in subdivision (a) and (b) of Section 113 have occurred and exist. Such retrocession would be in the best interest of the State.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT THE HEARINGS HELD ON JUNE 30, 1977 AND JULY 28, 1977, COMPLIED WITH CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 113 AND THAT THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN SATISFIED.

3. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION AND RECORDING ON BEHALF OF THE COMMISSION OF ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR AN ACCEPTANCE OF A RETROCESSION OF CONCURRENT JURISDICTION AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO MAKE IT EFFECTIVE.
