Dear Mr. Zengerle:

Thank you for your letter in which you requested the State of California to accept relinquishment of legislative jurisdiction of the six parcels of land located within Vandenberg Air Force Base and used by the State of California and the County of Santa Barbara for road purposes.

Easement Nos. DA-04-353-ENG-8284 and DA-04-353-ENG-9802 granted rights-of-way to the County of Santa Barbara and Easement Nos. DA-04-353-ENG-9046, DA-04-353-ENG-9812, NOY(r) 59650 and NOY(r) 62873 granted rights-of-way to the State of California. Additionally, a portion of Lompoc Casmalia Road not included in other rights-of-way is included since the road was in existence prior to acquisition by the United States. These parcels are more particularly described in the attached land description (Exhibit A) and depicted in the attached map (Exhibit B).

The State of California and the County of Santa Barbara have accepted conveyance of the lands for highway purposes and in accordance with our Streets and Highways Code. I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power vested in me by Section 77.5 of the Streets and Highways Code, hereby accept such legislative jurisdiction as necessary to permit the United States and the State of California to exercise concurrent jurisdiction over the easement areas and that portion of Lompoc Casmalia Road not within any easement area.

EXHIBIT "A"
LAND DESCRIPTION

Six parcels of land lying within Vandenberg Air Force Base, situated in Santa Barbara County, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1

All of the lands lying within the right of way granted to the County of Santa Barbara by Department of the Air Force, Road or Street Easement No. DA-04-353-ENG-8284, for San Antonio Road and a portion of Vandenberg Boulevard, as described in that certain deed recorded in Book 1947, at Page 782, Official Records of said County.

PARCEL 2

All of the lands lying within the right of way granted to the County of Santa Barbara by Department of the Air Force, Road or Street Easement No. DA-04-353-ENG-8284, for that certain portion of Lompoc-Casmalia Road, as described in that certain deed recorded in Book 1947, at Page 785, Official Records of said County.

PARCEL 2-A

All of the lands lying within a road right of way 100 feet in width, lying 50 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

BEGINNING at Engineer's Station 380 + 21.62 of the surveyed centerline of that certain portion of Lompoc-Casmalia Road as described in Book 482, at Page 288, Official Records of said County, said point of beginning also being the point of intersection of the centerlines of California Boulevard and said Lompoc-Casmalia Road, thence northwesterly, northerly, and northwesterly along the centerline of the existing pavement on said Lompoc-Casmalia Road to the intersection of said road with the northerly boundary line of Vandenberg Air Force Base, southerly of the town of Casmalia, and the end of the herein described centerline; centerline of said pavement shall be determined by dividing the width of existing pavement by two.

PARCEL 3

All of the lands lying within the rights of way granted to the County of Santa Barbara by Department of the Air Force, Road and Street Easement No. DA-04-353-ENG-9802 for that certain portion of Vandenberg Boulevard as described in that certain deed recorded in Book 2174, at Page 624, of Official Records of said County.

EXHIBIT "A"

PARCEL 4

All of the lands lying within the freeway rights of way granted to the State of California by Department of the Air Force, Road or Street Easements No. DA-04-353-ENG-9046 and No. DA-04-353-ENG-9812, for State Highway 1, as described in those certain deeds recorded in Book 2056, at Page 1007, and Book 2166, at Page 513, Official Records of said County.

PARCEL 5

All of the lands lying within the rights of way granted to the State of California by Department of the Navy, Road or Street Easements No. NOy(R)-57781, No. NOy(R)-59650 and No. NOy(R)-62873, for those certain portions of State Highway 246, as described in those certain deeds recorded in Book 1781, at Page 68, Book 1897, at Page 565, and Book 1932, at Page 971, all Official Records of said County.
