CESSION OF CONCURRENT CRIMINAL JURISDICTION TO THE UNITED STATES OVER A PARCEL OF LAND AT BORON, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

Pursuant to Government Code section 126, the Commission is authorized on behalf of the State to cede concurrent criminal jurisdiction to the United States upon finding:

- a. That the lands are used for federal purposes.
- b. The United States has in writing requested such cession.
- c. The cession is in compliance with the laws of the United States.

The U.S. Bureau of Prisons maintains a prison in Boron, California. Within that facility there is a Federal Aviation Administration facility. By letter dated November 20, 1981, signed by Acting Attorney General Rudolph W. Giuliani, and by letter dated March 25, 1982, signed by Secretary of Transportation Drew Lewis, the United States requested a cession of concurrent criminal jurisdiction over the above mentioned parcels.

The hearing was noticed in newspapers of general circulation and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors was served a notice of the hearing. The hearing was held on August 17, 1982. No comments regarding the cession were received at the hearing.


The staff believes that cession of concurrent criminal jurisdiction is in the best interests of the State and that it will facilitate the administration of criminal law over the parcels.
