ACCEPTANCE OF RETROCESSION OF LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION

Streets and Highways Code Section 77.5

Whereas the United States, acting through the Department of the Navy, by letter dated May 12, 1995 from T. E. Gunn, Captain, CEC, U. S. Navy to the Honorable Pete Wilson, Governor of the State of California, has requested that the Governor accept a retrocession of all legislative jurisdiction over the lands underlying three Grants of Easements to the State of California for highway purposes within Miramar Naval Air Station; and

Whereas the United States acquired these lands on May 7, 1941 pursuant to a Declaration of Taking in the case of United States of America v. 19,298.25 acres of land, Civil No. 105 filed in United States District Court for the Southern California; and

Whereas the United States acquired partial legislative jurisdiction over such lands after having complied with Section 34 of the Political Code of California and with Section 255 of Title 40 of the United States Code by letter dated October 1, 1943 from James Forrestal, Secretary of the Navy, to the Honorable Earl Warren, Governor of the State of California; and

Whereas the United States made two Grants of Easement to the State of California for highway purposes on October 6, 1994 and another on December 6, 1991, which have been duly recorded in the Office of the San Diego County Recorder on March 7, 1995 and which are identified as Documents 1995-0097029, 1995-0097030 and 1995-00977037 respectively. A metes and bounds description and maps have been made of record with the California State Lands Commission in file W 25225;

Now, Therefore, I, Pete Wilson, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power vested in me by Section 77.5 of the Streets and Highways Code, hereby accept a retrocession of all legislative jurisdiction over the above referenced Grants of Easement made to the State of California within Miramar Naval Air Station.

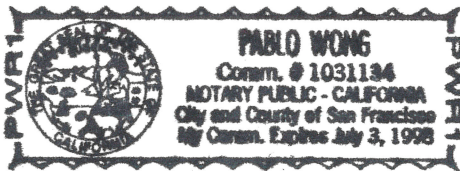
