Dear Commissioners:

Thank you for sending the May 23rd letter to Sable, acknowledging Sable's misrepresentation regarding its well testing as well as Sable's failure to inform the Commission of its plans to run oil through the offshore pipeline.

I urge you NOT to approve a lease holdover since Sable has proven to be unlawful, unreliable, not trustworthy and ignores court orders, Coastal Commission orders and orders from other state agencies.

Please write to the Office of the State Fire Marshal and reiterate the request for them to uphold their commitment to ensure the Sable comes into regulatory compliance and resolves its issues with all agencies before they issue an approval for restart.
